Greetings once again from beautiful Bavaria Germany. We have more good news to report this month as the Lord continues the work here in Illeshiem.

On the last Sunday in October, we enjoyed an exciting service with several people in attendance. During the invitation, one family indicated a need for salvation and I was able to set up a meeting at their house that very Halloween night. While little ghosts and goblins were practicing an ancient ritual house to house outside, three people prayed audibly and received Jesus Christ inside. To God be the glory! You preachers will certainly identify with the encouragement these decisions brought to our family. People are still getting saved!

Church attendance has been up, and the German man I asked you to pray for last time has been coming. Please keep praying for his marriage as his wife is considering divorce. One of the men here was deployed for a year, and his wife was in the states for 3 months. They are both here now, and have indicated a desire to be faithful. We need prayer and wisdom so that we might be an encouragement to this young couple.

As you know, there are several ways to grow a church and one of those ways is through the nursery. Hopefully you are sitting down because Stacy is expecting to deliver another Byers baby in May or June next year. Please take time to remember Stacy in your prayers. This will be the sixth c-section delivery for her and we certainly need the Lord's protecting hand.

Once again, I need to reiterate the importance of our monthly financial support. Just yesterday I opened the mailbox and discovered yet another church unable to continue supporting us financially. The church, like all the others, expressed remorse over the decision but they simply cannot maintain their current mission budget.

I believe the Lord is on the verge of doing some great things here. We will remain faithful to the Lord, but we need to be sustained on this mission field. Were it not for some friends sending extra money over the last 2 months; I have no idea how we could have paid our bills. Please, if your church is not supporting our ministry; I ask you to pray that your faith might be increased to include us in your mission budget. If you are currently supporting us, perhaps you could increase our monthly support by ten, twenty, fifty, or more dollars per month. Souls are being saved, and a church is being planted. Please allow us to finish what the Lord sent us to do.

In an unprecedented move by the local school administrators, our children have been excluded from mandatory classes and are only required to attend German language school, and some extracurricular activities such as sports. The administrators said they see the need for our children to graduate with a stateside diploma. This area of Germany has given homeschoolers the most difficulty bar none! Our victory is a result of God's power. Thank you for your help in ministry.
