To begin with, our hearts had just begun to heal after several people left the church, when God gave us two new visiting families. One stopped in out of curiosity and to refresh their English. They are a German couple that lives a few towns over. Another family started coming also. The man works as a civilian on the post, and his wife is German. They have one son who is bilingual and is about Josiah's age. I believe some of the people are not saved and we hope they will trust the Lord soon. Please pray the Lord will help us to keep these families and disciple them to spiritual maturity.

You will remember I asked prayer for Daniel. He is a German man who trusted Christ as savior a few months ago. Daniel stays in contact with me through e-mail, but recently he had surgery which kept him out of church. I believe he plans to attend this Sunday!

We have another couple who have been out of church for quite some time. The man deployed for one year, and his wife left four months ago to live with family in the States until he returns. They are both planning to attend Sunday so please pray about this also. None of the people who have attended are spiritually mature or serious about serving the Lord. Please pray for some faithful family to

come and be an encouragement to us and help us in the work.

A few days ago, the Lord blessed my Dad with a godly woman to marry. I firmly agree with God when He said "it is not good for man to be alone." And I thank God my Dad does not have to be alone now. The ceremony was in Washington State, but my family and I were able to attend via an internet video conference. In fact, Dad and Judy asked me to help officiate the wedding alongside Pastor Marty Stalnaker. I was delighted to be a part of the service, and things went extremely well.

Similarly, I was able to preach at the Fellowship Baptist Church in West Berlin, NJ last month. The pastor gave me 45 minutes and I never had to leave my house! We simply made an internet video call and the church projected my picture on a screen. I was also able to see and hear the church. I have two other meetings scheduled in this manner so far and I am searching for others. Would you allow me to share an update in your church? Several of you have not seen us in more than five years since we started deputation. We would enjoy seeing you and sharing an update on the work.
