Dear Friends and Supporting Churches,

Praise the Lord for His mercy, protection, and for his blessings to us. We thank you for your prayers as we continue to see our Savior guiding each step of our deputation ministry.

As things in Iran continue to escalate, how we wish we could be in Germany to witness to those military personnel who may be called to intervene with military might.

This month I spoke with pastor Herb Curriden at Eifel Baptist Church in Bitburg, Germany. The building where the church meets is now for sale and the church may have opportunity to buy it. Rent has been very expensive and some times the church is not able to purchase heating oil during the winter.

Would you please pray that Eifel Baptist could purchase that building for three hundred thousand dollars? That would be less than half the original asking price, but we trust our God is able! Even at that price, Eifel is not financially able to purchase the building at this time. Please make this a matter of constant prayer.

At the moment, I am in Alpine, TN attending a mission conference at Grace Baptist Church. I had to leave the family back in Vancouver during this week. I do miss them, however; we have been able to travel together for most of our deputation. As Stacy's delivery date draws nearer, we try to keep her at home more often.

While at Grace Baptist Church, I had the opportunity to preach in a prison. Two prisoners indicated that they needed and wanted to be saved, but only one came forward to talk to pastor Copeland. I hope these men will decide to accept the Gospel.

The Lord is leading our family to be in the North East part of the country for five

months this year. I hope you will check our web site occasionally to see our traveling schedule. At this time, we have meetings sporadically scheduled from October through January in the North East. We will be in Tampa, Florida during the first week of March.

If you know of any pastors who may allow us to present our ministry on the East Coast, I could certainly use the help in scheduling meetings. I would like to maintain a constant schedule during those months although traveling with a new baby will be very interesting. Please pray for our sanity during that time.

Just a week ago, our daughter Bella fell from a shopping cart and landed on her arm. We took her to the emergency room because I suspected a break. Bella will have a cast on her arm for six weeks. The blessing is; we may have cured her from sucking her fingers! Please pray for the break to heal correctly.

During April we were on our way home from a trip to Idaho when I announced to the boys that Tuesday would be fishing day." We got up early that morning and were on the lake to watch the sun come up. It was a beautiful day of catching brown trout and the boys had a stringer of twelve fish! We had some good pictures that I wanted to share in this letter, but Gabriel was walking by the lake with the camera and accidentally dropped it in. You will just have to believe that they were really big fish!

Aren't you glad the Lord is keeping track of the "fish" we catch as servants of God? It's good that we don't need proof for anyone else, but Jehovah God is righteously keeping track of the souls we win for Christ. Thank you for your continued faithful support and prayers.
