November is over and it is time to give you an update on our deputation progress. We continue to schedule meetings and visit churches each week. The Lord is blessing with great opportunities to visit new churches, and challenge Christians to get involved with the Great Commission on a global level.

Stacy had the privilege of leading two young ladies to Christ this past month. We are excited about this blessing, and we trust the girls will follow the Lord in baptism very soon.

In the last letter, we wrote to you about the automobile accident in which our van was totaled. Those of you on our E-Mail list received an update about our new transportation. We only had to miss one meeting because of the accident and no one was injured. We thank God for his mercy and his provision. We now have a nice 2001 van for deputation and hope to have it paid for in short order.

During the past couple of months, I asked a few people to pray about my claim with the Veteran's Affairs (VA) office. I never fully recovered after my head injury and I continue to have difficulty in concentrating and with my short term memory. The Veteran's office did some tests and evaluated me at 30% disability. This means I will have a military ID card to use for the rest of my life. I trust the Lord had this in mind when I fell from the horse and hit my head. Praise the Lord for his insight!

Please pray about the possibility of receiving medical coverage through the VA for my family and me. If I am able to secure these benefits, it may cut my required support by nearly \$800.00 per month. The Lord knows how to provide, please keep this matter in prayer.

I would like to take this opportunity to

remind you that our soldiers, sailors, airmen and marines are deployed throughout the world this Christmas season. During a time celebrating "peace on earth", the air force believes peace is achieved through superior air power. While I enjoy the idea of the United States maintaining global air superiority; we know Jesus is the Prince of Peace. Please think of them and pray, and perhaps take the time to write to a soldier this Christmas and thank them for their service. Your patriotism may be the tool God would use to win some lost troop for Christ.

As I loosely follow the news these days, I can't help noticing all the calamity in the world. The unrest means more deployments for our troops. These things remind me of the urgency of my mission. I must return to Germany and begin ministering to the men and women of our military before they are called upon to make the ultimate sacrifice. Many have already been killed in action with no hope of heaven. Please allow the Lord to burden your heart for these heroes, and pray God will speed our way to the field. Jesus said; "I am the way the truth and the life, no man commeth unto the Father but by me."

If you know a church that would consider supporting a military missionary, please do not hesitate to put me in contact with the pastor. We are doing our best to follow the Lord in presenting and sharing our burden. Currently, 45% of our needed support is coming in each month. While we visited many churches over the past four months, few of these churches have begun supporting our ministry yet. We hope and pray to reach the 50% mark next month. Would you pray that our goal will be met? We appreciate your love for the Lord Jesus and for our ministry.
